Power Wheel Derby Rules

- 1. Judges can rule that children won't participate if there are modifications to the car more then those allowed that are stated below.
- 2. Children 3-10 years of age may participate. There are two age groups 3-5 years old and 6-10 years old.
- 3. One parent/guardian per child will be allowed in the derby arena.
- 4. Derby is limited to 6-12 volt power wheels only. No connecting multiple batteries together. Can have a 12 volt lawn mower/motorcycle battery. Battery <u>CAN NOT</u> be mounted to passenger side seat or floor board. Battery must be secured and sealed away from child.
- 5. No added reinforcements for strength.
- 6. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use duct tape or zip ties to keep them shut.
- 7. Stock tires only, no screws in tires, chains ect.
- 8. All vehicles must be stock height. No raised or lowered vehicles allowed.
- 9. Decorative changes can be made to power wheels to make it look like a derby car. However no reinforcement can be added to the power wheels
- 10. Helmets are mandatory! Bike helmets are okay.
- 11. Sneakers or work boots are required. No sandals!
- 12. Must wear a long sleeve shirt and pants. No shorts or tee shirts.
- 13. Must have some sort of seat belt and must be used during the event.
- 14. No passengers allowed during event.
- 15. Everyone will receive something for participating. This will vary from event to event.
- 16. No 4 wheelers, tractors or motorcycle power wheels will be allowed in the derby's.
